- Builds trusting and positive relationships with volunteers and TBC staff involved in the music and tech team ministries
- Assists, as appropriate, in daily congregational care
- Provides positive, collaborative servant leadership with the Campus Pastor on overall strategic planning and direction of music, tech, and worship ministries
- Provides a model for all who attend The Bible Chapel by being an example of personal integrity, discipleship, and evangelism.

Experience: The Director of Worship must be proficient to plan, prepare, and lead corporate worship services instrumentally and/or vocally.
